What We Do

Progressive Child Care Academy, Inc. (PCCA) strives to meet the individual needs of each child enrolled in the center by providing quality curriculum and activities. We believe that giving care, love and learning are essential to our program. Our primary goal is to provide each child with a loving, caring, respectful and fair environment.

We strive to provide an honest, safe, and clean learning environment for children aged 6 weeks to 12 years. We believe that children learn best by parent and teacher involvement and by use of their academic, cognitive, social, and fine motor skills. We plan activities that will enhance these skills such as writing, learning, and recognizing names, ABC's, number, shapes, etc.

We will also enhance running, skipping, lifting, grasping, holding, cutting, drawing, reasoning, and imagination as well as relating to the expression and refining of the child's own feelings. Another goal is to challenge, motivate and stimulate each child to develop his/her capacity intellectually, physically, socially and emotionally. At PCCA, we also encourage a positive self image and make learning exciting and fun. We believe that giving care, love and learning are essential to our program.

Caring Staff

Our staff is committed to fostering a comprehensive and balanced educational program for all students. We believe students must be taught through assessment based instruction, remediation and enrichment. Staff members must have understanding of the developmental stages of children and teach to various learning styles. It is our belief that student achievement is reached through collaboration with the home, school and community. We encourage children to become enthusiastic learners by providing them



with choices and opportunities to be responsible for themselves to the degree appropriate to their level of development. We value the play of young children as their means for translating experience into understanding. Learning opportunities are presented through well planned play activities, which are concrete, real and relevant to the lives of children. We offer:

These forms need to be on file before the child begins attending PCCA. All spaces on the form must be filled in with information. Parents are required to update all changes of phone numbers, addresses, emergency contacts and pick-up persons as the changes occur.

Tuition & Fees

Tuition fees are determined on a fiscal year basis and are the actual cost of operating PCCA. Payment is based on a continuous twelve-month period even when the child is not present. No credit is given for absences due to illness or vacations and no credit is given for scheduled school holidays. Parents of children enrolled at PCCA will receive a 30-day advanced written notice of any increase in tuition. Tuition payments can be made to PCCA utilizing cash, check or money order. Tuition payments are due in full by the 3rd of the following month. Payments that are more tan 14 days late will constitute to toice of intent to cancel enrollment.
